**Maritime Ontario** will continue to enhance our fleet over the next 24 months, beginning with the arrival of 150 new temperature controlled containers, doing our part to support the food and grocery markets across Canada.

This new equipment features Slim Line technology, a slimmer design allowing room for two additional pallet positions, creating 7% more capacity than a regular container with 15 pallet rows instead of the traditional 14. This model is also exclusively using the next-generation refrigerant R-452A, a greener option, which lowers GHG output by approximately 50% of the commonly used refrigerant.
